UPDATE December 28, 2012:

- Racing begins at 9am – 11am, 2pm – 3pm. Free style will have the water when ever there is 'down time' in the hydro racing. Water will be handed over to PWC from race referee.
- APBA PWC rules will be strictly enforced.
- No children in the PWC racing pits. All families and children must be in the area set aside next to the pits.
- All fuel must be in the secured FUEL DUMP in the pit area
- NO DOGS in the racing pits at any time.
- No pop-up tents allowed in the hydroplane hot pits. (per King County Fire Marshall) Pop-up tents are allowed in the family area next to the PWC racing pits.
- All participants must sign waiver and have wrist band on to enter the PWC pits.
- Participants are not allowed to enter the pits except for the designated pit entrance.

Please note the following details:

- Bring your PWC down on Friday to get it in place during Hydro Happy Hour. Security starts on Friday. PWC must be on site by 8:30AM on Saturday and Sunday (per King County Fire Marshall). **GATES CLOSE TO BOATS AT 8:30AM.**
- No driving on grass except for designated areas. FOLLOW SIGNS!!
- If you plan to leave before 6pm on Sunday, you must hand carry or quad your PWC out to the parking lot. (rule per Park Rangers)
- Park closes at dusk (approx. 9pm). Please be out of the park by then.
- **Your pit pass wrist band is entry into the event if you are in uniform – please share this information with your crew. Entrance gates start charging at 9am.**
- Children UNDER the age of 12 are not allowed in the hot pits. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Remember with hydro racing, there will be lots of action on the water at TnR. Please make sure that you follow all rules and road signs. We want to provide the best racing action for the crowds, so we all need to work together to ensure that the action is only on the water!!!

AWARDS CEREMONY- will start right at **6pm**, sharp!!! We need to honor our sponsors, so we **STRONGLY** encourage you to show up. It will be a great time and we will keep it to a 30 min. ceremony!!!

We do appreciate your cooperation. PWC/Boat racing is show business, so let's give them a show!
