#### **UPDATE December 28, 2011:**

**In order for the pits at Tastin' n Racin' to be properly laid out, we are asking entrants to PLEASE pre register!! Race fees **DO NOT** need to be sent with your early registration.**

Entry fees of \$30.00 for each boat registered with fees covering Region 10 and APBA taxes voted upon by its members. There will be a **\$30.00 late fee** for registration received after June 1, 2012

- Tastin' n Racin' will be administrating Breathalyzer Test for each driver in the morning both Saturday and Sunday. (APBA rule 1.2.1, general safety rule)
- **We will have a very full schedule, and this year we **MUST** hold tight to the 6 boat count per class rule. Make sure you get your class ready if you want to race at TnR.**
- No pop-up tents allowed in the hydroplane hot pits. (per King County Fire Marshall) Pop-up tents are allowed in the spectator's area.

Please note the following details:

- Bring your boat down on Friday to get it in place during Hydro Happy Hour. Security starts on Friday. Boats must be on site by 8:30AM on Saturday and Sunday (per King County Fire Marshall). **GATES CLOSE TO BOATS AT 8:30AM.**
- Motor homes and passenger cars **WILL NOT** be allowed down the path to the pits. If you tow your boat with an RV, please bring it to gate 3 at the East end of the main parking lot. Tell a yellow shirt security person and we'll get a truck to bring your boat to the pit area. **Only vehicles towing boats** will be allowed down the path to the pits.
- Authorized GP race gear trucks will be allowed near pits – one per team. Make sure you have the special authorization pass to put into your windshield to avoid getting a ticket by the Park Rangers.
- **Boats will remain in place until 6:30pm Sunday. Only the Race Director** can authorize exceptions to this rule and for long distance racers leaving directly from the pits for home or their next race site will get authorization.
- Park closes at dusk (approx. 9pm). Please be out of the park by then.
- **Your pit pass wrist band is entry into the event if you are in uniform – please share this information with your crew. **Entrance gates start charging at 9am.****
- Rangers request that all boat work is done and pits are emptied by 8:00pm. If you have a repair that will take longer, please contact Jon Courtright. Rangers plan to enforce this request.
- Children UNDER the age of 12 are not allowed in the hot pits. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Remember with PWC racing, there will be lots of action on the water at TnR. Please make sure that you follow all rules and road signs. We want to provide the best racing action for the crowds, so we all need to work together to ensure that the action is only on the water!!!

**AWARDS CEREMONY-** will start right at 6pm, sharp!!! We need to honor our sponsors, so we **STRONGLY** encourage you to show up. It will be a great time and we will keep it to a 30 min. ceremony!!!
