## PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, HIDRO, Inc. (Helping Issaquah Develop Recreational Opportunities), a non-profit group in Issaquah, was formed to make available a variety of free or very inexpensive recreational alternatives for citizens of King County; and

WHEREAS, a current project of HIDRO, Inc. is working with LAP (Lifeguards at the Park) in improving the safety of swimmers at Lake Sammamish State Park by funding lifeguards during summer months; and

WHEREAS, on June 2 and 3, 2001, HIDRO will host Tastin' n Racin' 2001, a family festival at Lake Sammamish State Park that includes the Unlimited Light Racing Series, food booths, live music, arts and crafts, activities for children; boat and auto exhibits and more; and
